



## Guidelines for Poster Presentations

### Specific requirements for this conference:

Posters will be accepted provided that the presenter attends the conference and is present at the poster sessions at the times designated to supply explanations and/or answer questions from visiting participants or members of the Conference Committees.

### Design and Layout, specifications:

The poster's dimensions should not exceed A0 size (84.1 x 118.9cm), portrait position. A banner displaying the title of the poster, the name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliation should be positioned at top-center. The poster must be laid out in a logical fashion and it should be obvious to the viewer how to extract and understand the information it contains. The poster should read from left to right, and top to bottom.

### Lettering and Figures:

Lettering for the title should be large. Font type and size are not restricted. However, text should be readable from a distance of 2m. Simple typefaces are preferable to fancy fonts. Figures should be simple and bold and must contain sufficient detail to be able to stand alone, i.e. graph axes clearly labeled, symbols fully explained, etc.

### Content:

The content of the poster should encapsulate and present the findings of completed or ongoing research. The text should be as concise as possible. The organization of the content may vary, but it is recommended that the poster should consist of the following main sections: introduction, methods, results, discussion, conclusion, and key references (it is recommended that no more than 3 references are included). The results and discussion sections may be combined and the conclusion section may be omitted.

### Best poster competition:

All registered posters will be entered automatically into the Conference poster competition.
